Other Exemptions

The following programs require compliance with the expanded immunization requirements, which include varicella, tuberculosis testing, and influenza. Students will not be required to complete further yearly tuberculosis testing or influenza vaccinations if all of the following conditions are met:

- 1. The student must have complied with all Health Sciences immunization requirements upon admission.*
- 2. The student must have completed the first year of the program.*
- 3. The department chair must certify that the student will have no patient contact for the remainder of their studies.*
